Notice of Race

1. VENUE

The **Austrian Lakes Week 2005 – EUROLYMP (ALW)** will be held from the June 29 to the July 3, 2005 on Lake Neusiedl (Neusiedler See) at Neusiedl.

The **Austrian Lakes Week 2005** is an ISAF Ranked Event and an **EUROLYMP** Event.

2. ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

The Organizing Authority is the *Austrian Sailing Federation* in conjunction with local clubs.

3. DISCIPLINES / CLASSES

4. RULES

The event will be governed by:

- the *Rules* as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing, EUROLYMP Regulations, Class Rules (except as any of these are changed by this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions).
- The prescriptions of the Austrian Sailing Federation for Austrian Championships 2005 (Wettfahrtordnung)
- This Notice of Race
- The Sailing Instructions

5. ELIGIBILITY

The ISAF Eligibility Code shall apply.

6. ADVERTISING

The ISAF Advertising Code shall apply.

Boats may be required to display a bow number and advertising stickers of the event sponsor on either side on the forward 25% of the hull. Sailboards may be required to display such number and advertising stickers on either side of the sail above the wishbone.

7. PENALTIES

The Two Turns Penalty, RRS 42 (for Mistral as modified by Appendix B4.3) will apply, except for 49er and Tornado, for which the two turns are replaced by a one turn (altering RRS 44).

8. ENTRIES

Not later than 15th June 2005.

Entries shall be made on the official entry form or through the e-mail form on the events website only. Any entry received after 15th June 2005 will be subject to a 50% late entry additional charge.

All entries, when accepted, will be displayed on the ALW website. This display can be considered as a confirmation.



Teams will be exempted from paying an entry fee provided they are ranked in the Top 10 of the most recent ISAF World Sailing Ranking issued before June 15th 2005 and provided they display the name of the helmsman, crew and nationality flag in the mainsail. Entries from teams ranked in the Top 10 received after June 15th 2005 will be charged the normal entry fee.

9. ENTRY FEES

Single handed and board: € 50,00

double handed: € 90,00

10. PAYMENT OF FEES

The above mentioned fees must be paid only in Euros (€) at on-site registration prior to competing in the **AUSTRIAN LAKES WEEK 2005 – EUROLYMP**.

11. ON-SITE REGISTRATION

Competitors and Team Leaders shall complete on-site registration at the Registration Office / OeSV Competence Centre

for 470: on June 29, 09.00 – 12.00

all other classes: on June 29, 15.00 – 20.00

on June 30, 09.00 – 12.00

Each crew shall present at the Registration Office:

- Measurement Certificate and Measurement Form
- Third party liability Insurance Certificate (Original).
- a valid membership card to his/her MNA, if any.

Sailing Instructions will be available at the moment of the registration.

12. SAIL NUMBERS

Boats shall use the approved National Code Letters in their sails as required by RRS. In alteration of their Class Rules, their national letters on the sails shall apply for any class. Competitors may be required to wear bibs (provided by Organizing Authority).

13. MEASUREMENT

Prior to the races all sails must be measured, authorized by Class Rules and/or Class Championship Regulations and stamped by the Measurement Committee.

14. COURSES

Same as in ISAF guidelines for Olympic Games.

15. RACES

Three races (49er: Four races) are scheduled per day.

There can be sailed one extra race per day to bring up the schedule in time.

Six races will constitute a series.

16. COMPETITION FORMAT

The Competition Format has been developed in close consultation with other World Cup Organizers and ISAF and follows as close as possible the guidelines for Olympic Games. All entered competitors will have the opportunity to sail until the last day of racing.

First warning signal of the first race:

470: Wednesday, June 29, 14.00

All other classes: Thursday, June 30, 14.00

No warning signal will be made after 14.00

for 470 on Saturday, July 2, 2004

all other classes on Sunday, July 3, 2004.



17. SCORING SYSTEM

The Low-Point System will apply.

The Organizing Authority reserves the right to amend the scoring system through the Sailing Instructions.

18. PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded for the teams finished on places 1, 2 and 3 in the Final Results.

The best ranked Austrian sailor will receive the title "Austrian Champion 2005 in the ...-class" and the prize given by the Austrian Sailing Federation. If the winner of the series is not an Austrian sailor he will receive the title "International Austrian Champion 2005 in the ...-class".

19. INTERNATIONAL JURY

An International Jury will be appointed in accordance with RRS 87.2.

The above mentioned schedule may be changed by Organizing Authority through Sailing Instructions.

21. RIGHT TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS

In participating in the ALW, a competitor automatically grants to the Organizing Authority and the sponsors of ALW the right in perpetuity, to make, use and show, from time to time and at their discretion, any motion pictures and live, taped or film television and other reproductions of him/her during the period of the competition for the said ALW in which the competitor participates and in all material related to the said ALW without compensation.

22. SUPPORT BOATS

Mechanically propelled boats are generally prohibited on Neusiedler See, however, during this event a special permit to use such boats may be issued by the Organizing Authority producing the necessary documents listed here below:

- Motor registration document
- Driver's identity document
- Navigation license for motors with 40 hp or more
- Insurance of the boat

Each support boat shall fly a specific flag which will be supplied to the assigned boats by the Organizing Authority together with the navigation permit. No other individual team support boats shall be used.



23. LIABILITY AND INSURANCE

Competitors will participate in the ALW Regatta entirely at their own risk. The Organizing Authority, all Race Committees and the Jury will not accept any liability for personal or material damage, injury or death, sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during or after the ALW Regatta. The Organizing Authority disclaims any and all such liability.

Each competing boat needs to take a valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of € 1.000.000,00 per event for the entire duration of the ALW-Regatta. It shall be the sole and inescapable responsibility of the competitor to have and provide written proof thereof to the Organizing Authority upon request.
