Notice of race

ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

The Organizing Authority is the Sports Nautiques de l'Eau d'Heure club (S.N.E.H.), in cooperation with the "Europe Sailing Promotion" association and the Belgian Europe Class association, the Belgian French Federation of Yachting (F.F.Y.B.) and the Royal Belgian, Sailing Federation (F.R.B.Y.).

1) RULES

The regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012

The prescriptions of the Belgian authority will apply.

The following prescription may require advance preparation :

"G2 Identification on sail- Boats participating in a competition taken back in the national calendar in Belgium have to respect the prescripts of the rule G1"

The rules of the Europe Class

The rules for the navigation on the Plate Taille Lake will apply.

If there is conflict between languages the French text will take precedence.

2) ADVERTISING

Advertising will be restricted to Category C according to the ISAF Advertising Code -Regulation 20 with a special restriction: the Belgian Law of 10/12/1997 prohibits any advertising for tobacco products.

3) ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1 The regatta is open to females aged 30 or more during the year of the contest and to males aged 35 or more during the year of the contest.

3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the form on the website www.aloisrolandtrophy.be or the attached form and sending it to L'association Europe Sailing Promotion ESP Chaussée de Louvain 46 à 1320 Hamme-Mille ou par mail to europesailingpromotion@gmail.com. The entry fee will be paid on the Europe Sailing Promotion bank account by the 1 august 2009, to IBAN BE59 0003 2560 2526, BIC BPOTBEB1.

The entry fee is fixed at 75€ including entry drink Wednesday august the 26th at 19H00 and the diner Friday august the 28th.

For non competitors, the diner price will be 18€

Every night, a good fire will be lighted so anybody will be able to cook his meat.

A reducing of 5€ on the entry fee will be accorded to any competitor who will participate at the 2 regattas: "Alois Roland Trophy" the former WE (22 and 23 august 2009) and at this "Vétéran Cup"..

3.3 Late payment will be accepted under the following conditions: Only in ready money, no cheque and only in Euro, at the registration office.

3.4 Every competitor shall be member of his class association and must drawn a licence as required by his federation.

At the moment of their registration, the competitors shall present:

- a valid licence
- a valid letter of measurement
- a valid certificate of advertising issued by their National Authority.

3.5 Each competitor shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of EUR 2 000 000.00 per event or the equivalent.

4) PROGRAMME

4.1 Wednesday the 26th from 10h00 to 12h00: registration.

4.2 Racing days

Wednesday 26th: 1st warning signal: 13h00 - races to follow.

Thursday 27th: 1st warning signal: 10h00 - races to follow.

Friday 28th: 1st warning signal: 10h00 - races to follow.

Saturday 29th: 1st warning signal: 10h00 - races to follow, no warning signal after 15h00.

4.3 Price giving

Saturday 29th about 17h00.

5) SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available during the registration at the registration desk.

6) THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be: Triangle.

7) SCORING

7.1 Three (3) races are required to be completed to validate the "Veteran Cup". The maximum number of races is 8.

7.2 (a) When fewer than 6 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race score.

(b) When from 6 to 8 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race score excluding her worst score.

8. RADIO COMMUNICATION

A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

9) PRIZES

Prizes will be given as follow: 3 Open - 3 female aged more than 50 - 3 male aged from 50 to 59 - 3 male aged more than 60.

10) DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The Organizing Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

11) INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with a valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of EUR 2 000 000,00 per event or the equivalent.
