Youth Sailing marking the EU Enlargement

Yachtclub Breitenbrunn will be organising in 2004

Blue Sky Racing Days

on May 1 and 2,

We invite young yachtspeople (male and female) sailing classes Optimist, Zoom8, Laser-R, Europe, 420 and 470 to attend. Last year approx. 160 young sailors in some 100 boats entered for this event. As a special feature there will be a separate classification for senior sailors in the Laser-R (resp. Laser, if there are entries) class, so that fathers, mothers and trainers can also participate.

This year's event has EU enlargement as its motto, as on May 1, 2004 Slovakia, Hungary and Slovenia, the countries bordering on Burgenland, will be joining the EU.

First contacts with the sailing associations of Slovakia and Hungary have already been established. A number of preliminary registrations have already been received, so that we expect to host approx. 200 participants this year.

The aim of this initiative is to extend the good cooperation with neighbouring countries and to set new impulses for the sailing area of Lake Neusiedl.

Helmsmen are required to be members of a registered yacht club, a national association, or any other association registered at ISAF. All helmsmen must have Licence Card "A" or equivalent.

Rules: ISAF Rules, Racing rules, Sailing Instructions of Austrian Sailing Association, class rules (latest edition) and invitation to competition.

Entry fee: One hand classes € 25.--, Two hand classes € 30.—

1st Start: Saturday 1.5.2004 - 14:00 hours.

Race Office / Registration: Race Office in the Clubhouse, open on 30.4.2004 from 16:00 hours to 19:00 hours and on 1.5.2004 from 08:00 hours to 12:30 hours.

Course: Short courses (approx. 50 minutes) will be sailed with a minimum length of 6 sm.

Classification: If 5 races are sailed there will be one discard. If 4 or less races are sailed there will be no discard. To classify as a "SP" a minimum of 3 races must be sailed. Low Point System according to RR appendix A.

Prizes: There will be prizes for 25% of the number of participants listed at close of registration period. Souvenir prizes will be given to all participants present at the prizegiving ceremony.

Trainings: Training sessions may be undertaken on Saturday 24.4., Sunday 25.4. and Friday 30.4.2004 at the Yachtclub. Please notify the club in advance.

Helmsmen's briefing: 1.5.2004 at 12:30 hours.

1st Start: Saturday, 1.05.2004 - 14:00 hours. Signals for further races will be set on the starting vessel and the club mast or posted on the official notice board in the club house.

Prizegiving Ceremony: approx. 1 1/2 hours after the finish of the last race.

Social Programme: Saturday 1.5.2004 by invitation of Yachtclub Breitenbrunn: food, drinks, photos taken during the races, music.....
